While not native to Blacksburg, the Red Eyed Tree Frog's bright colors and seemingly friendly smiles fit well with our incredible landscape and eco-friendly valley.

This window is part of a collection of four windows on Simply Elemental 2018 that were painted in 2017 for the public art event "My Windows on Blacksburg" sponsored by the Blacksburg Regional Art Association and held at the Alexander Black House Museum and Cultural Center. Over 15 works by both BRAA members and other local artists were displayed. Several of those artworks remain in place on the house lawn today.

In 2018, local artists created two dozen windows "My Window on the New River Valley" now installed in the lawn and garden of the Montgomery Museum and Lewis Miller Regional Art Center on S. Pepper Street in Christiansburg.

These four windows have been included in Simply Elemental 2018 to let you anticipate next year's presentation "My Window on the Hahn Horticultural Garden", expected to be installed in May 2019.
